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SPECIAL RULES

Please take note of the rules and guidelines for each item.

1. Certificates are awarded according to symbols.
2. A candidate may not present the same work in more than one category of the same section.
3. A candidate may not present the same work in two consecutive years.
4. Please ensure that language used, is appropriate for an eisteddfod forum.
5. To be considered for an award the candidate should at least participate on the same day of the specific section.
6. Competitors' dress: Black leotard & black tight (Girls) or black shirt or black T-shirt with short trousers or black tracksuit pants. School uniform may be used for the Sight reading, Verse and Prose speaking.
7. All competitors must introduce themselves as well as the piece performed to the adjudicator.

If the participant's home language is AFRIKAANS, he/she must enter
in section A.**



PREPARED INDIVIDUAL ITEMS

Poësie (EAT01)

- Own choice.
- Formal approach without movements or gestures.
- No props.
- Interpretation through voice and facial expression.
- Full body integration with relaxed posture.

EAT01 Grade 00-12 R100

Grade 00-0 1½ minutes maximum

Grade 1-7 2 minutes maximum

Grade 8-12 3 minutes maximum

Gedramatiseerde Poësie (EAT02)

- Own choice.
- Interpretation is supported by motivated movements and gestures that reinforces the word.
- Drama blocks, ladders and chairs may be used.
- No props or costumes.

EAT02 Grade 00-12 R120

Grade 00-0 1½ minutes maximum

Grade 1-7 2 minutes maximum

Grade 8-12 3 minutes maximum

Prosa (EAT03)

- Own choice.
- Formal approach without movements or gestures.
- No props.
- Interpretation through voice and facial expression.
- Full body integration with relaxed posture.

EAT03 Grade 1-12 R100

Grade 1-7 3 minutes maximum

Grade 8-12 4 minutes maximum



Gedramatiseerde Prosa (EAT04)

- Own choice.
- Interpretation is supported by motivated movements and gestures that reinforces the word.
- Drama blocks, ladders and chairs may be used.
- No props or costumes.

EAT04 Grade 1-12 R120

Grade 1-7 3 minutes maximum

Grade 8-12 4 minutes maximum

MonoLoog (EAT05)

- Drama Gear: Black Leotard & Tights or Black T-shirt (without signage or branding) & shorts.
- Use of minimum décor, hand props and suggested costume.
- Movements and gestures should be motivated in support of the subtext.

EAT05 Grade 4-12 R120

Grade 4-7 3 minutes maximum

Grade 8-12 5 minutes maximum

Voorbereide Redevoering (EAT 06)

- The topic and arguments of the speech must be specific, clearly formulated and substantially defended.
- Cue cards are allowed.

EAT 06 Grade 1-12 R100

Grade 1-3 Maximum 3 minutes

Grade 4-7 Maximum 4 minutes

Grade 8-12 Maximum 5 minutes



UNPREPARED INDIVIDUAL ITEMS

Onvoorbereide lees (EAT07)

- 5 Minutes preparation.
- Adjudicator supplies the age-appropriate reading piece for reading.

Grade 4-7 1½ minutes maximum

Grade 8-12 2 minutes maximum

PREPARED ENSEMBLE ITEMS

Poësie DUO (EAT08)

(‘n 4 of 5-minute program van poësie voordrag deur twee deelnemers)

- Own choice.
- The poems may be dramatized.
